- I. Online (email) quotations are invited on behalf of Government of Kerala for the providing Cryogenic Liquid Medical Oxygen container vehicle on rental basis as per the terms & conditions given herewith:-

II. TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

1. The vehicle shall be fitted with cryogenic liquid Medical Oxygen container for transport of Liquid Medical oxygen from the production plants to various hospitals in the State of Kerala.
2. The tank shall be vacuum double walled construction manufactured in accordance with a type or standard or code as specified under rule 13 and fitted with fittings approved by the Chief Controller.
3. Should have facility to refill liquid oxygen from the production plant and to refill the storage tanks installed in hospitals.
4. The vehicle should have facility to fill liquid oxygen from ISO containers.
5. Should have valid PESO approval.
6. Should have valid registration and insurance as per Motor Vehicle Act.
7. The capacity of the tank shall be 10 Tonnes (± 1) / 15 Tonnes (± 2) / 20 Tonnes (± 3).
8. The vehicle should be provided with trained experienced drivers with valid license for 24x7 operation.
9. All vehicles should have GPS tracking system and the provision to track the vehicle shall be provided to Government authorities.

III. SCOPE OF THE BIDDER

1. The quotation is invited for hiring tanker vehicles for transporting liquid medical oxygen from the manufacturing plant to the hospitals across Kerala.
2. The bidder may either own the vehicle or shall have valid lease agreement with the owner of the tanker vehicle.
3. The driver for the vehicle shall be provided by the bidder for 24x7 operation.
4. The drivers shall have valid license and shall be trained on all safety aspects of Liquid oxygen.
5. The driver shall be trained to offload liquid oxygen from the tanker to hospital storage tanks.

6. It is not mandatory that a bidder shall provide the entire fleet of tankers required. The bidder can quote only for the readily available vehicle.
7. The contract period is initially for 3 months and may be extended if required.
8. The fuel for the vehicles shall be borne by the bidder. The bidder shall quote the monthly rental charges for one vehicle of the available capacity.
9. The road tax and insurance shall be paid by the bidder.
10. The maintenance of the vehicle shall be done by the bidder.
11. The vehicle should be in good running condition and should have good tyres.

IV. OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Prospective bidders are requested to submit the quotations through e-mail to **kmsclepqt@gmail.com** up to 11.00 am, 18.05.2021. Offer received during **13.05.2021 to 18.05.2021 up to 11.00 am** will only be considered.
2. The quotation documents are published on the website of KMSCL www.kmscl.kerala.gov.in. The excel file as per the format given along with the quotation notice shall be submitted. The price bid shall be submitted as per format given along with quotation notice. The filled in price bid shall be submitted in pdf format after protecting with a password.
3. The following documents shall be submitted by the bidders and the language for bid submission shall be English.
 - a. Quotation document in the excel format attached along with quotation notice.
 - b. Company registration certificate
 - c. GST registration certificate
 - d. Details of vehicle available as per format in Annexure
 - e. Price bid as per format in pdf and it should be password protected.
4. Quotation documents submitted in any other format shall not be considered. Incomplete or partially filled quotation documents shall also be not considered. The quotations received without price bid shall be rejected. If password of the price bid is not provided after evaluating the technical bid, upon request from TIA, then the offer will be rejected.
5. Quotations submitted by Consortium / joint quotation (one quotation mentioning two company names) will not be considered. Blacklisted / debarred firms by central or any state Government or any Government organizations / institutions are not eligible to offer quotation and will be rejected.
6. The offer of the firm not matching with the stipulated technical specifications will not be considered. It is mandatory that all the stipulated documents shall be attached along with the quotation, failing which the offer will not be considered.
7. The price bid shall be offered for each capacity of vehicle separately. The rate per vehicle shall be offered for covering a minimum distance as mentioned below.

8. The rate for additional kilometer shall be offered in the price bid.
9. The rate for additional kilometer will be reimbursed if the average distance per month covered by all the vehicles of a type deployed, crosses the stipulated distance during the contract period. For example, if two 10 tonne vehicles are deployed for three months, the additional kilometer charges will be paid if the total distance covered by both the vehicle crosses 60,000 kilometres.
10. The price bid of the prospective bidders whose offer meets all the stipulated technical specifications, who submits all the documents as per the quotation document will only be considered. The password of price bid will be sought through email only if the offer meets all the stipulated conditions. The bidder who meets all the technical specifications and submits all required documents satisfactorily and offers the lowest per test rate will be declared as the L1 bidder. The result will be published in KMSCL website after due evaluation by the committee. If more than one eligible bidder offers the same lowest rate, then the order quantity will be split equally.
11. All the vehicles should have a log book. The odometer readings of the vehicle during the start and end of every trip shall be captured with location details. Each trip shall be signed by the officers in the locations.
12. Every month 24 hours will be allowed for repair works for a vehicle. If the downtime is more than 48 hours and the minimum distance per month is not covered, then penalty will be deducted for every additional day of repair. The per day penalty will be calculated by dividing the quoted amount per vehicle by 30 days. If the non performance is less than 24 hours then the per day penalty amount will be proportionally taken for every 6 hours.
13. The invoices shall be raised monthly. **100% payment through RTGS** transfers against submission of invoices and details of trip details will copy of log book within 15 days of submission of documents to KMSCL head office. All statutory deductions are applicable.
14. The successful tenderer shall execute an agreement for ensuring satisfactory service.
15. The quantity mentioned is only indicative. The quantity may either increase or decrease as per the actual requirement. The Tender Inviting Authority reserves the right to cancel the quotation and invite fresh quotes at any point of time irrespective of the quantity of orders issued, if the market rate of the item falls below the rate fixed in the quotation.
16. The rate quoted shall remain valid for 60 days.

17. Splitting of Contract: If the L1 bidder could not provide the vehicles within the stipulated period, then orders will be issued to the matched L1 bidder. If more vehicles are required and the L1 bidders do not have the capacity to provide the same, then orders will be issued to L2, L3 and so on. Notwithstanding anything as stated above, considering this an emergency procurement for Covid -19 pandemic management. Procurement Agency/Purchaser with approval of Competent Authority can decide to award contract to other bidders if situation so demands for the Covid-19 pandemic management.
18. The decision of the Competent Authority in respect of splitting of contracts shall be final and binding upon all the bidders. The Procurement Agency/Purchaser reserves the right to cancel the bid in part or full without assigning any reason and liability on the buyer. On such cancellation the decision of the Procurement Agency/Purchaser will be binding and final on the subject.
19. If the successful bidder fails to deliver the vehicles within the stipulated time period, the Tender Inviting authority reserves the right to cancel the supply order and issue to the next lowest bidder at the risk and cost of L1 bidder, if the L1 rates are not matched.
20. The terms and conditions of the quotation document alone will prevail and any other conditions mentioned by the in the documents submitted by the bidders will not be considered.
21. The Tender Inviting Authority reserves the right to take any action deemed fit for any kind of tender violation by the bidders.
22. If dispute or difference of any kind arise between the Tender Inviting Authority and the bidder/ supplier in connection with or relating to the contract, the parties shall make every effort to resolve the same amicably by mutual consultations.
23. If the parties fail to resolve their dispute/difference by such mutual consultation within twenty-one days, then either the purchaser or the supplier shall give notice to the other party to commence arbitration, as per the provisions in Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 or any amendment thereof.
24. In the case of a dispute or difference arising between the Tender Inviting Authority and a bidder relating to any matter arising out of or connected with the contract, such dispute or difference shall be referred to the sole arbitration of Smt. Anupama T.V, Director, Women and Child Welfare, Govt. of Kerala whose decision shall be final.
25. Venue of Arbitration: The venue of arbitration shall be the place from where the contract has been issued, i.e., Thiruvananthapuram, India.
