Choking Training Manikin

1. Realistic manikins available in child, adolescent, and adult sizes.

2. Allows practice of abdominal thrust, chest thrust, and back blow procedures for clearing the foreign body

3. Manikins should be made of durable material to create tactile realism.

4. When correct clearing procedures are performed, the manikin should be able to expel the object causing the obstruction.

5. Each manikin should have a ribcage, xiphoid process, and jugular notch to provide anatomical reference points for the demonstration of hand placement.

6. Manikins should include choking objects and a soft carry bags.
